Looking for a new job can be hard. There are many different places to search for job postings, both in person and on the internet.

Here are some places you can look for jobs:

- Job search websites:**
Many businesses will put information about job openings on a job search website like the Government of Canada Job Bank or Indeed.ca.
- Business website or social media:**
Is there a business you want to work for? Employers often post new jobs on their own website in a “jobs” or “careers” section, or on their social media accounts like LinkedIn or Facebook.
- “Hiring” signs:**
Some businesses put signs in their windows when they’re hiring.
- Networking:**
You can ask family and friends, or past coworkers and supervisors if they know about any available jobs.
